## How to install and use the CyberArk Desktop Authenticator



Install the CyberArk Desktop Authenticator on your workstation to generate time-based one-time passcodes to enter when logging into an application protected by CyberArk Identity. The app is similar to the CyberArk Identity mobile app.

## **Installing the CyberArk Desktop Authenticator**


- Open the downloadable file at:

Click Compressed Folder Tools at the top of the window.




• Click the Extract all icon.


• The setup wizard will open. Click **Next**.


 Begin the CyberArk Authenticator install. Click Install.








 You will receive a message when the installation is complete. Click Finish.
