### Under-Represented in Medicine Scholarship 2023

#### Baylor Scott & White Medical Center- Temple Emergency Medicine Residency

**Proposal:** Baylor Scott & White Medical Center – Temple Emergency Medicine Residency Program in Temple, Texas would like to offer visiting students the following scholarship program to promote diversity, inclusion, and cultural sensitivity.

**Goals of Program:** We are strongly committed in promoting diversity, inclusion, and cultural sensitivity. By providing this scholarship, we will be able to highlight the above, and enhance the visibility of our program in hope to encourage students from different backgrounds to apply to our residency. We hope to provide equal opportunity and prepare these students to enter the competitive world of medicine regardless of race, ethnicity, or socioeconomic class. Examples of diversity would include but are certainly not limited to: historically underrepresented ethnicities in medicine, those who may be socioeconomically or educationally disadvantaged, and any others whose backgrounds and/or experiences would bring diversity.

#### Details:

- There will be two scholarship recipients for 2023 visiting students. Rotation start dates for our 4-week clerkship are the following:
  - June 5
  - July 3
  - July 31
  - August 28
  - September 25
- Scholarship recipients will be reimbursed up to \$2,000 for travel, housing, and other living expenses while completing a 4-week emergency medicine clerkship at Baylor Scott and White Medical Center - Temple.
- Applicants will receive guidance and mentorship from our outstanding faculty to help the applicant shine during their clerkship.
- Applicants will rotate in our busy tertiary care Level 1 trauma center and help in care of our complex patient population.
- Our EM Residency has a wide variety of expertise in Administration, Critical Care, EMS, Disaster Medicine, Toxicology, Ultrasound, Medical Education, Pediatric Emergency Medicine, Research, and Simulation.

#### Criteria:

- This opportunity is available to the underrepresented in medicine. It can encompass any of the following but not limited to:
  - Racial and ethnic populations that are underrepresented in medicine
  - Socioeconomically or educationally disadvantaged
  - Any others whose background and experiences that would bring diversity
- Student must be in good academic standing at an accredited medical school within the United States.
- Student must be a full time fourth year medical student or a third-year medical student that has completed all required core clinical clerkships.

**How to apply:**

- Student must submit one Letter of Recommendation from a faculty member who can attest to the student's commitment to a career in Emergency Medicine.
- Student must complete a visiting student application.
- Student must submit a CV.
- Student must write a brief (< 500 words) summary of why they are underrepresented in medicine and why would they like to rotate with us.
